Club Constitution

Name

- The Club shall be called Longford Girls Football Club.

Aims and Objectives

- To promote the playing and enjoyment of football for girls throughout the community.
- To arrange association football matches, training and social activities for it's members.

Membership

- Membership of the Club shall be open to any girl 8 years or older who has an interest in playing football.

Fundraising

- The Committee shall be responsible for all fund raising activities.
- The Committee will decide how any funds raised through organised events shall be used although suggestions from the club shall be considered.
- The Club will seek sponsorship to contribute to running costs/new equipment/team kit.

Committee Members

- The club shall be run by a Committee that will run the affairs of the club and will comprise of the following
- Chair
- Secretary
- Treasurer

Finance

- All matters that will involve the club incurring expenditure must be dealt with by the Committee
- Players will pay a weekly subscription that will be set at the Annual General Meeting
- The club will open and run a bank account and all cheques written on behalf of the club will require 2 signatures. Chair, Treasurer, and Secretary being authorised to act as signatories.
- The Treasurer shall effect all money transactions and shall make a financial statement at each Committee meeting (normally every 4-6 weeks during the season)
- The Treasurer shall make the club bankbook and all accounts available for inspection at every meeting.
- The Treasurer shall produce a written statement of the audited accounts for the AGM and an independent auditor appointed at the AGM will audit these.
